11.106	<p><b>New Hall Project</b> - Cllr Ellis reported that the project was moving forward and at the meeting last night options for the design and then the build were progressed. Before any contracts are signed some finance queries with Nikki Pugh will be formalised. Planning consent will be required before grants could be pursued and help may be required with the technicalities of grant getting. Graham Ford had a good meeting with Mr Jukes and the boundaries are as in the plans.</p> <p>There is a fund raising group under the VHMC who have arranged approx two events a month until March next year. – Discussion was had about how to publicise in the parish – JW offered a notice board and would speak to the village shop. (Tea party on 31/7/11 at Walcott Hall).
